<b>Progress/Accomplishment of Goals &amp; Objectives</b>	
<p>DVP students have been receiving training bi-weekly by instructors in using Lyft and Uber apps on their phones. 9/10 students have been successful in booking transportation to social venues as a practice with their peers.</p> <p>With DVP student efforts in securing transportation, they have expressed the feeling of independence and “finally feeling like an adult”.</p> <p>We do face many challenges in transportation in Fallbrook though. There are not many Uber or Lyft drivers in Fallbrook and when our students do secure a ride it is expensive. One of our students, who is now an enthusiastic Uber user, was hired by a local business. She utilizes the Uber app on her phone daily to get to work and spends almost \$12.00 a day in transportation cost! That would be \$240.00 a month in just transportation expense.</p> <p>DVP is trying to find other sources of reliable and cost effective transportation in Fallbrook for our students.</p>	

## CHC Quarter 2 Impact Narrative

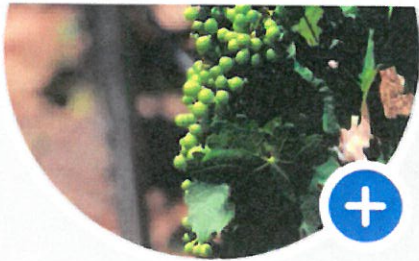
The funds we receive from CHC has impacted many of our student's lives. At October's graduation, a parent pointed out to us that the program has affected not only their young adult child's life but everyone who is associated with their child. Their child "Amy" has graduated and has been hired by a local agriculture business. She enjoys her new job and all the skills she is learning-some she's applying from DVP program. Her parents are overjoyed that Amy is excited to wake up every morning; to work along side one of her graduated classmates on the ranch, to participate in DVP weekly socials, to help with various events at the ranch, to attend various events where she can show off her new agriculture knowledge, and to have a purpose. The ranch owners who have hired her enjoy her company and are excited about Amy's enthusiasm. Amy uses her knowledge of the Uber app for transportation every day. Without this, her job would not be possible.

One day during Thanksgiving holiday, my husband and I were out of town, Amy texted me stating that her anxiety level was very high and she needed to destress. She asked if she could come to D'Vine Path and just sit at her usual chair where she used to sit in class and just relax. I told her, all our graduated students are always welcome back to DVP. I am happy they have found a safe haven. But even happier that they can secure a ride to it.

We are incredibly proud of our students and are amazed at the progress they have made socially and intellectually. They have built positive peer relationships, shown self-advocacy, discovered their social strengths, and developed communication and social skills. They showed our community what people with disabilities are capable of- if given the chance.
