provide intensive care management for patients within the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 1 for Goal #1 Process referrals for at minimum 40 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Actions: In Q1, between July 1 and September 30, 2021, Champions for Health has processed referrals for one new patient from FRHD. Three referrals were denied initially due to missing documents, or eligibility issues and we are working with our referral partners to strengthen intake information. We are following up with these referrals still to ensure patients and partner staff are supported to complete intake.

Objective 2 for Goal #1 Provide intensive care management to at minimum 40 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Actions: Intensive care management was provided to three patients from FRHD to attend 5 appointments/consultations with our pro bono specialty physicians.

Objective 3 for Goal #1 Provide support to overcome the social determinants of health for at minimum 40 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Actions: CFH staff provided transportation support for all five patients to attend their appointments, and all services were provided at no cost to patients. Patients who required lab tests, imaging, or medication received it at no charge.

Additionally, during Q1 our public health intern was offered full time employment. In order to build program strength, and expand effort to support practices, outreach to specialty physicians, and increase the number of patients we can see we hired one new full time PASD care manager who will support FRHD efforts.

Participant Success Story:

One continued success story is Rosario, who received care through PASD for cataract surgery through the generous support of FRHD's funding, and our expanded referral network that focuses on FRHD residents. Rosario continues to benefit from care coordination, and is receiving continued aftercare through two physicians, no cost medication (eye drops and injections) is provided transportation to and from appointments, and is provided medical interpreting through PASD.

As this new PASD care manager ramps up, we expect to see more referrals to reach our goal of 40 patients this year.
