GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Goal 1 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.

By June 30,2021 Champions for Health will recruit two community based practitioners to refer a minimum of 10 low-income, uninsured patients through Project Access, and provide intensive care management for patients within the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 1: Recruit at minimum 2 community-based providers.

Objective 2: Train and provide support for 10 referrals to PASD.

In Q2, we have launched a landscape analysis of all small community based practices in Fallbrook to offer partnership for providers, with much hesitancy received. Materials were created to facilitate referral, introduce Fallbrook practices to the program, and in-person visits. Our next step will be to work with community clinics to enhance the availability of PASD through Neighborhood Health Care (an existing partner) and through new partnerships with Fallbrook Family Health Center.

Goal 2 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.

By June 30,2021 Champions for Health will facilitate specialty healthcare for a minimum of 10 low-income, uninsured patients through Project Access, and provide intensive care management for patients within the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 1: Process referrals for at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 2: Provide intensive care management to at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 3: Provide support to overcome the social determinants of health for at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Measurable progress in Q2 includes

5 PASD patients served through q2
1 new PASD patients enrolled during program year
2 Surgeries
6 of PASD appointments/consults
15 Lyft/transportation provided.

While we have not solidified new partner relationships, we continue to serve Fallbrook residents, and providing services to address the social determinants of health.

PARTICIPANT SUCCESS STORY

Participant Success Story:

The new patient that was enrolled in FRHD through Project Access San Diego is a 67 year old resident of Fallbrook who is unemployed, and married. Without children, and low social supports, our patient has struggled accessing and maintaining care due to lack of transportation while her husband works. In August, through Fallbrook Regional Health District's investment, the patient was able to access a retinal specialist, ophthalmologist, and received cataract surgeries in both eyes, once in August 2020, and again in December 2020, as well as post-surgery care and consultations. The surgery was provided by our partner North Coast Surgery Center. The patient was provided Lyft transportation from Fallbrook to and from her appointments, as well as medical interpreting. Thank you for making access possible.

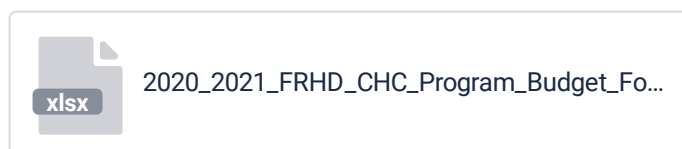
