FHRD Swim Grant Narrative

This summer, Daniel Z. attended our program for the first time. He was finally able to join in on the fun that his two sisters, Araceli and Elsita, had been having for the last year. These three siblings came to our community from Central America, and while their mother works hard towards the American dream, her children are working hard towards learning new life skills- one of which is swimming!

Daniel and his sisters were raised in a Spanish-speaking household, but none of them can hear. They were all born with a congenital condition that makes them deaf, and no one in their past homes had ever learned any kind of sign language, so the trio could only communicate using their own system of charades. This would be a learning obstacle for anyone but Daniel. He jumped head-first- literally- into swimming lessons with the enthusiasm of any other 4-year-old. Because of his zeal and his inability to hear instructions, he was assigned a one-on-one swim instructor. His instructor had to physically always stay within arm's length of him- his natural curiosity was constantly and dangerously at odds with his lack of swimming experience. During his lessons, he learned how to hold his breath, how to float on his front and his back, how far away the bottom of the deep end is, and how to make his way to the wall after flinging himself into the water. Everything he learned was from experimenting and copying his instructor, and he made impressive headway in only 2 weeks! Although his life skills learning journey required double the amount of energy, supervision, and creative problem-solving, the lifeguards are eager for Daniel to return to the pool and continue his lessons.
