Objective 1: Co-facilitate, with the FRHD, monthly Community Collaborative for Health and Wellness (CCHW) meetings, except for December.

Objective 2: Offer:

-school based dental screenings, fluoride varnish application and education to 2nd graders in the Fallbrook Elementary School District and Bonsall School District.

-school based dental screenings to kinders and 1st graders in the Fallbrook Elementary School District and Bonsall School District who need their oral health assessment form completed

-conduct school based dental screenings and education to all students at Vivian Banks and Vallecitos Schools.

Objective 3: Offer BMI and blood glucose screening to 5th and 7th grade children in the Fallbrook Elementary School District.

Objective 4 Conduct community based health screenings.

Measuring Success for Goal 1:

Goal 1, Objective 1:

-Quarter 2, 2 CCHW meetings held

Goal 1, Objective 2:

-Quarter 2, 100% of Bonsall and Vallecitos School District dental screenings/education completed and 75% of Fallbrook School District screenings scheduled (we usually try to do all school based dental screenings in the Fall, however, the Fallbrook School District has requested it be done later in the school year).

Goal 1, Objective 3:

-Quarter 2, schedule 75% of the school based BMI/blood glucose screenings.

Goal 1, Objective 4:

-Quarter 2, complete at least 2 health screenings

Outcomes:

Goal 1, Objective 1: 2 CCHW meetings held (October and November).

Goal 1, Objective 2: Due to COVID-19, the school districts remain with altered schedules. Fallbrook Smiles Project has not been able to schedule or provide our usual dental screenings and education. This quarter we have, instead, been able to provide an alternative. We have given the Fallbrook and Bonsall School Districts dental "goody" bags to be handed out to each 2nd grade student. These goody bags consist of a youth toothbrush, toothpaste, flossers, 2 minute brushing timer and dental themed pencil. In addition, each 2nd grade teacher was provided with information including dental curriculums they may use to teach, movie links, activity sheets, information about dental providers in our area as well as the restorative dental

care program. At Vivian Banks school in the Bonsall District, all students, regardless of grade level, received a dental goody bag and all teachers were provided the information. This was done as this is a small school with high need. Participant data is pending from the Fallbrook Elementary School District and from Bonsall Elementary and Bonsall West Elementary. We have only received data so far from Vivian Banks School. That is why there are only 92 for the answer of the question above " How many District residents directly benefited (participant/client)from this program." The remaining data will be added to the quarter 3 report.

Goal 1, Objective 3: Due to COVID-19 schedule changes in the Fallbrook School District, we have not been able to schedule the BMI/blood glucose screenings. We are in discussion with the District Nurses about possible alternatives.


Goal 1, Objective 4: Due to COVID-19, we have not been able to provide any community health screenings this quarter. We are in discussion with the Fallbrook Food Pantry and Fallbrook Senior Center as well as the CSUSM School of Nursing regarding resuming some programs as the nursing students plan to return to Fallbrook for their Spring semester.

Dear Second Grade Teachers,

Fallbrook Smiles Project usually comes to see your class in the Fall of each year to do oral health education, provide goody bags of supplies (like toothbrushes, toothpaste, flossers and timers) and offer dental screenings. However, due to the many changes of 2020, we have not been able to provide these services. So, we have come up with an alternative!

We have put together the information in this letter for you. It includes oral health curriculums and activities you can use with your class in order to provide any dental education you would like to do. We have also added links to the movies that we typically show the classes. We are still supplying the dental goody bags which you can pass out to each child in your class. In addition, we have supplied you with a list of dentists in the Fallbrook and Bonsall areas including notations of which ones accept Medi Cal. Please know that Fallbrook Smiles Project has a dental restorative program for adults and children for dental care beyond the basics covered by Medi Cal or private insurance or if no dental insurance is available. Eligibility is residency in the Fallbrook/Bonsall/Rainbow area and income 200% or less of the federal poverty level.

We provided the Fallbrook Elementary School District with a diabetes training kit to be used by the District Nurses when instructing staff about the care of children with diabetes. This included glucometers and testing supplies. In the past we have assisted the District Nurses with providing the staff education and have given them educational curriculums, items and handouts.

We provided the 501c3 non-profit Love On Your Back with

dental oral care items (toothbrushes and toothpaste) for distribution to their recipients. Love on Your Back (<https://loyb.weebly.com/>) provides food and hygiene items to students (and the families) of the Bonsall School District. Due to COVID-19, there is an increased need for provisions for these families.

One person was served in the restorative dental program this quarter.
