GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Goal 1 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.

By June 30, 2021, Champions for Health will provide a flu vaccine to at minimum 250 residents of the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

Objective 1: Confirm existing FRHD partner sites to implement FY 2020-201 flu vaccine.

Objective 2: Respond to new requests for flu clinics from potential FRHD partners.

Objective 3: Identify low-access and low immunization locations to outreach to such as nurseries, trailer parks, and faith-based locations.

In Quarter 2 we have been successful in scheduling 5 events in the Fallbrook Regional Health District from October - December, and serving 329 residents out of a goal of 250. We look forward to serving many more FRHD residents in the coming months as Winter continues and Q3 gets underway.

Goal 2 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.

By June 30, 2021, Champions for Health will serve 50 youth ages 7 - 17 through the Vaccine for Children (VFC) program.

Objective 1: Confirm existing FRHD VFC partner sites to implement FY 2020-201 flu vaccine.

Objective 2: Respond to new requests for VFC clinics from potential FRHD school

Objective 3: Implement VFC clinics at FRHD school sites.

In Quarter 2 we have been successful in scheduling 2 of 5 events in the Fallbrook Regional Health District from October - December at schools, although not being able to provide VFC vaccine distribution due to COVID restrictions. Nonetheless, we provided vaccinations to 30 youth and 47 of their family members at school sites.

PARTICIPANT SUCCESS STORY

Participant Success Story:

In any busy flu season, when geographic demands and low resources affect the distribution of limited resources, organizations like Champions for Health can be stymied by their ability to reach those places that are home to the most underserved. Fallbrook Regional Health District's investment has allowed Champions for Health to nearly double its impact in Fallbrook, De Luz, and Bonsall in just the first three months of the flu. This impact will also affect learning and rollout of future COVID vaccine efforts, as well as inform how best to serve communities like Fallbrook.

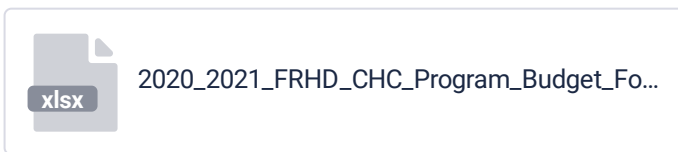
