

Why Is Redistricting Necessary?

- The District adopted Resolution No. 428 on June 19, 2019 proactively establishing zone-based elections, adopting map and election sequence based on 2010 Census, as required.
- By-district means the voters in each individual zone vote for a representative residing in that zone.
- The first by-zone elections:
 - 2020 Zones 2 and 4
 - 2022 Zones 1, 3 and 5
- Every 10 years the federal government conducts the Census, requiring review of zones to insure balanced population.



Role of the Board

- Ensure compliance with procedural requirements
 - Hold public hearings
 - Adopt new zone map before statutory deadline.
- Provide direction to staff and consultants
 - NDC has prepared two draft maps for Board consideration that meet compliance with federal requirement for equal population.
 - Board may provide additional guidance to demographer on zone boundaries prior to finalizing the map.








Hispanic CVAP Demographics








