## **GOALS & OBJECTIVES**

### **Goal 1 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.**

By June 30, 2021 Champions for Health will recruit two community based practitioners to refer a minimum of 10 low-income, uninsured patients through Project Access, and provide intensive care management for patients within the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

CFH has recruited two community based providers: Fallbrook Medical Center, and Fallbrook Family Health Centers to provide services. This quarter we served 3 FRHD patients through 4 pro bono consults, and accepted 2 new referrals.

#### Objective 1

Recruit at minimum 2 community-based providers.

-Two community based providers have been recruited, and 1 of 2 MOUs have been finalized.

#### Objective 2

Train and provide support for 10 referrals to PASD.

-Training and support have been provided to one provider on two training occasions to initiate 2 new referrals. New training and supports for remaining referrals have been initiated.

### **Goal 2 & Objectives: From your application, please provide your measurable outcomes for each of your stated objectives.**

By June 30, 2021 Champions for Health will facilitate specialty healthcare for a minimum of 10 low-income, uninsured patients through Project Access, and provide intensive care management for patients within the Fallbrook Regional Health District.

#### Objective 1

Process referrals for at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

#### Objective 2

Provide intensive care management to at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

-To date, intensive care management has been provided to 4 unique patients from the FRHD.

#### Objective 3

Provide support to overcome the social determinants of health for at minimum 10 patients from Fallbrook Regional Health District.

-Patients enrolled and served receive support for the social determinants of health through scheduling of free Lyft transportation to/from appointments and support to coordinate Lyft rides, free diagnostic, pharmaceutical and durable medical equipment assistance if necessary.

# PARTICIPANT SUCCESS STORY

## Participant Success Story:

Our most important success(es) this quarter were formalizing 2 new referral relationships to our system, all possible due to the generous support FRHD is providing to enable access to care through financing program support for new patients. This support has allowed us to enroll one previously unidentified provider, after a lengthy and instructive landscape analysis, as well as supported facilitating initiating care at Fallbrook Family Health Center, which we had attempted before but had not been successful. Trust building between our two systems of care through participation in the CCHW and FRHD collaborations have allowed us (we think) to move this relationship forward. Thanks to FRHD we are a "known partner" in a different way than an organization which is otherwise seemingly centered in "Central San Diego" - THANK YOU FRHD staff and board for allowing these trusting relationships to emerge.

We look forward to sharing additional patient-participant success stories in our next report, for now, our collective system possible a community "win".
