Mission



Fallbrook Family Health Center Resource Fair



The Fallbrook Family Health Center – Resource Fair was a great success. The purpose of this event was to connect community members to essential resources that may have been difficult to locate in the Fallbrook area. Many residents have difficulty finding necessary resources in the Fallbrook area due to lack of transportation and other defining obstacles. CHSI acted as a catalyst in providing knowledge to its patients, and community members alike.

Fallbrook Family Health Center had over **20 Community Agencies**, more than **114 attendees (signed up)**, and **provided 253 Health Screenings**, (Medical, Dental, or Vision), to the Fallbrook Community.

University Community Health Center 2nd Annual Community Resource Day



The purpose of this event is to promote the wellbeing of the community by providing them with important resources that are often out of their reach due to lack of transportation, childcare, or simply lack of knowledge of such services. This event was open to all and we offered services that target the homeless, children, adults, the elderly, teens, LGBTQ community, and many more.

University Community Health Center had over **20 Community Agencies**, more than **250 attendees**, made **50 clinical appointments**, and **provided 143 Health Screenings**, (Medical, Dental, or Vision), to the Riverside Community.

Magnolia Community Health Center Back to School Event



Following the true spirit of the CHSI mission and vision – Magnolia Community health Center gave out over 400 backpacks to children in their community, and raffling off 3 bicycles. Magnolia staff worked tirelessly in over 110 degree weather to support the massive outpour of support from the community. Many children and teenagers walked away with supplies needed for academic success!

Magnolia Community Health Center had over **20 Community Agencies**, more than **400 attendees**, and **provided 130 Health Screenings**, (Medical, Dental, or Vision), to the Riverside Community.


