**Program Goal #1**  
 Improve the health and wellbeing of grandparents raising their grandchildren in

objective and provide your outcome data accordingly.

Fallbrook and its neighboring communities of Bonsall, Rainbow, and De Luz by providing a comprehensive service that promotes a strong and stable family.

#### Objective 1.1

Improve family functioning and decrease family stress by providing customized case management services and parent coaching.

Measure 1.1: By 6/30/22, 22 grandparents will be connected to the services and supports they or their grandchildren need including parent coaching and report decreased stress and improved family functioning on self-report surveys administered quarterly.

Quarter 1 Update: 18 grandfamilies have received case management services this quarter and were connected 69 times to needed services and supports. In addition to regular check-ins for personalized support, referrals were made to 11 different types of services.

Self-report surveys for Quarter 1 will be sent mid-October.

#### Objective 1.2

Decrease social isolation and increase connection to a community of mutual support by providing weekly monthly support groups.

Measure 1.2: 12 grandparents will participate in at least one support group a month for 6 months by 6/30/22 and report decreased feelings of loneliness and improved mood on a self-report survey administered quarterly. The number of support groups held and the number of grandparents participating will be recorded weekly. Grandparents will also be asked to rate the benefit of educational topics offered in the group. The results of surveys will be recorded quarterly.

Quarter 1 Update: 9 grandparents have attended the support groups offered each month this quarter. Surveys on satisfaction with support groups will be sent mid-October.

Participant Success Story:

Grandparents Angela and Aquilino have been receiving services for one year and six months. They are raising two of their Grandchildren. Case manager Graciela has been part of their journey with the adoption process for the past twelve months which entails a lot of paper work and county requirements such a, court hearings, medical appointments for the whole family, time, money and gathering information.

At the grandparents request Graciela has been present for most of their court hearings remotely at their home (helping them set up computer, email, making sure camera and audio is on...etc.) On 10/7/21 Graciela was present when the Judge finalized the adoption for Angela's and Aquilino's two Grandchildren. It was such an amazing experience to witness such an enormous event for the family. It was very emotional and all the hard work that was put into the process was so worth it. Without the support of the program and the funding of the Fallbrook Regional Health District, it is quite possible the adoption would have been delayed or never have taken place.
